Car parking - be safe and considerate

The car park area of the school needs to be used in a safe and considerate manner. Please may I take this opportunity to remind you of a few of the basic school car park rules:-

- Firstly, please ensure that if you are driving into/out of the car park that you do so at a slow pace 10 miles per hour or less is recommended.
- The drop off area is to be used for dropping off or collecting. If you arrive substantially early, please do not use these spaces for parking.
- The disabled bays are **only to be used** by those who require it.
- The area at the end of the car park marked with yellow crossed lines is <u>not</u> a car parking space. This needs to be kept vacant in order to allow cars to turn safely if the car park is full.
- We respectfully request that when parked in your car that you do not keep the engine running. This is not only bad for the environment but causes exhaust fumes to discharge at the same height level of children passing, causing them to inhale them.

And finally, although not within the school car park itself, it has been brought to my attention that cars parked just out with the school car park can on occasions cause an obstruction of view to allow safe entry/exit into the school car park.

Please be considerate when parking and if need be park a safe distance away from the school grounds and walk to collect your child (ren).
